Modern Mental Health Units require a comfortable heating system that integrates with the standard plasterboard soffit whilst retaining a degree of structural integrity appropriate for the environment. Working with the design team, Frenger's standard Atrium radiant heating panel was developed with an integral aluminium frame and lockable access hatch; the frame allows for simple integration with the plasterboard soffit whilst allowing for product expansion during the heating cycle, the access hatch facilitates access to the valves etc. and obviates the need for unsightly plasterboard hatches.

The panel and access sets were sized to meet the dimensions and heat losses particular to each room. The heating panels and run-out pipework were fitted by our own specialist installation team.

This "MHU" solution is now available for use in other Mental Health Units.
